2023 | Ca' Marcanda Vistamare | Tuscany, Italy

The only white wine produced by the Gaja family in Tuscany is a textural blend of Vermentino, Fiano and Viognier. The generous and slightly marine nose is followed by a remarkable complexity of roundness and herbaceous notes.

2023 | Pieropan Calvarino Soave Classico | Veneto, Italy

Pieropan family's tradition in wine dates back to 1901, when they purchase the historical Calvarino vineyard. The volcanic soils and the steep slopes produce a rich and mineral driven wine, famous for being first Italian white wine labelled as single vineyard.

2023 | Giulia Negri, Pian delle Mole, Langhe Nebbiolo | Piemonte, Italy

Giulia Negri is one of Barolo's rising stars, blending tradition with fresh ideas. This Langhe Nebbiolo reflects her style; elegant, precise, and full of energy. This varietal is known for its refined tannins perfect for the richness of our meat dish.

2022 | Piero Gatti, Moscato Frizzante | Piemonte, Italy

Light and slightly bubbly, this is the perfect pair with a creamy gelato.

2021 | Elena Walch | Vigna Kastelaz | Alto Adige, Italy

This is a distinguished white wine crafted from a renowned single vineyard in Tramin, Italy. Situated on a steep, south-facing slope, the Vigna Kastelaz vineyard produces a full-bodied wine with a creamy texture, balanced by fine saline undertones and a refreshing acidity. This is one of the best Gewürztraminer produced in Europe.

2022 | Armand Heitz Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, La Maltroie | Bourgogne, France

This is a refined expression of Chardonnay from Burgundy's esteemed Côte de Beaune region. Sourced from the La Maltroie Premier Cru vineyard, this wine showcases the distinctive terroir of calcareous brown soils rich in marl, contributing to its depth and aromatic complexity.

2019 | Elvio Cogno, Barolo Cascina Nuova | Piemonte, Italy

Young vines can make a great Barolo that can be enjoyed without having to wait 20 years. This is what Valter wanted to prove, and it has been achieved with brio. This textbook Barolo shows intense aromas of rose petals and present itself in a delicate tannin structure true to its origins.

2022 | Prophet's Rock Vin de Paille Pinot Gris | Central Otago, NZ

This is a rare Central Otago sweet wine crafted from hand-selected berries dried on straw mats to intensify purity and concentration. This is not produced every year, only in exceptional vintages, It tells a story of patience, precision and the winemaker's devotion.

2023 | Alfio Cosentino, Vigna Don Paolo, Etna Bianco | Sicilia, Italy

This expression of Carricante from the volcanic soils of Mt. Etna displays an energy bursting with citrus oils, white flowers and a good pinch of salt. The palate is rich while still having bright acid to wrap around the fruit.

2023 | Domaine de la Suffrene, Bandol | Provence, France

Embrace the holiday feeling with this rich rosé from the famous hills of Bandol; perfect combination with our seafood pasta.

2023 | Pietradolce Etna Rosso, Nerello Mascalese | Sicilia, Italy

Grown on the volcanic slopes of Mount Etna, this Etna Rosso shows the character of its unique terroir. It's a clear expression of Nerello Mascalese, fresh, mineral, and true to its mountain origins.

2017 | Cantine di Dolianova Moscato di Sardegna | Sardegna, Italy

Grown on limestone and granite soils around Dolianova and crafted by the renowned Sardinian cooperative, this moscato shows purity and lifted aromatics.

2021 | Müller Catoir, Bürgergarten Erste Lage Riesling | Pfalz, Germany

From the historic vineyards of Haardt, Müller Catoir crafts this elegant Riesling from the prized Bürgergarten "Erste Lage". Sunlit slopes and cool Paltinate breezes shape its pure citrus and mineral precision. A wine of quite power-refined, poised, unmistakably Pfalz.

2021 | Elena Walch Beyond the Clouds Chardonnay | Alto Adige, Italy

Alto Adige's first super cuvée was born in 2000. Ever since, Elena Walch and her two daughters have been producing one of Italy's best chardonnays.

2022 | Azienda Agricola Sciara 980 metri, Nerello Mascalese | Sicilia, Italy

Sourced from ungrafted Nerello Mascalese vines at 980 metres on Etna's north-facing Contrada, where thin volcanic sand and extreme diurnal shifts shape precision. A wine defined by altitude-driven tension, low yields, slow ripening and mineral-rich basalt translating into finesse.

2011 | Château La Tour Blanche, Sauternes, 1er Grand Cru Classé | Bordeaux, France

One of my longtime favorite Châteaus in Sauternes. The Château, and its vineyards, was gifted by his previous owner to the French government in 1909 with one condition: they had to create a winemaking school within its walls. 2011 was a brilliant vintage for La Tour Blanche and the wine shows hint of confit pineapple and vanilla.
